CRAFTSMANSHIP

PARTICIPANT WILL BE JUDGED ON INVENTIVENESS AND ENTERTAINMENT VALUE.

PARTICIPANT WILL BE JUDGED ON LOOK AND FLOW OF COSTUME, AS WELL AS ACCURACY IN MOVEMENT TO THE ORIGINAL CHARACTER.

PARTICIPANT WILL BE JUDGED ON HOW WELL THE PERFORMANCE CONVEYS THE COSPLAYER'S ADMIRATION FOR THE ORIGINAL CHARACTER.

ACCURACY-PARTICIPANT WILL BE JUDGED ON HOW WELL THE COSTUME DIRECTLY COMPARES TO THE ORIGINAL ARTWORK.

QUALITY-PARTICIPANT WILL BE JUDGED ON HOW WELL THE COSTUME HAS BEEN PUT TOGETHER, INCLUDING THE FIT, NEATNESS OF PAINTING, SEWING, ETC.

*A COSTUME WITH A WIDE VARIETY OF DIFFICULT SKILLS WILL BE AWARDED HIGHER MARKS THAN A COSTUME THAT USES SIMPLE TECHNIQUES.

PREJUDEINE REQUIRED 2ND FLOOR ROOM IN ELEVATOR LOBBY

- BEST INDIVIDUAL ADULT (18 AND UP) - PRE-JUDGING @ 1000 - BEST INDIVIDUAL YOUTH (17 AND BELOW) - PRE-JUDGING @ 1100

- BEST GROUP ADULT PRE-JUDGING @ 1200
- BEST GROUP YOUTH PRE-JUDGING @ 1300

RULES & GUIDELINES

- All costumes will be family friendly appropriate and absolutely no GLITTER
- All prop weapons must be carried in plain view and cannot be concealed.
- Staves, bokken, shinai and wooden swords are permitted.
- All fake, prop or homemade weapons are permitted if they are in no way dangerous to attendees.
- All weapons deemed unsafe by KeeslerCon event staff must be removed from the event.
- Misuse of any weapon or prop, such as swinging it in a public area or causing a hazard to attendees, will result in
 the weapon or prop being deemed unsafe for the event. If a weapon or prop is deemed unsafe for the event due
 to misuse, it will be removed from the event.
- Metal weapons of any kind are not permitted.
- Guns and projectile weapons are not permitted. Examples of guns and projectile weapons include, but are not
 limited to, working guns, pellet guns, BB guns, air guns, crossbows, dart guns and blowguns.
- Replicas of guns or projectile weapons are permitted if they are easily identifiable as props.
- No ammunition of any kind is allowed at the event.
- Nunchaku and other flail weapons are not permitted.
- Incendiary devices are not permitted. All devices which spark, shoot flames, burn, smolder, can otherwise cause combustion, or which exist for no purpose other than to be lit with a combustion device, are considered incendiary devices.
- Illegal weapons are not permitted. SFS will be notified if any illegal weapons are found in any person's possession.
