

# Hurricane Season is from June 1st to November 30th

If you will be gone from your site (and leaving your RV there) for any reason during hurricane season, you will need to let the office know.

# **Hurricane Preparation List**

- Medications/medical supplies (7 day supply)
- Water (1 gallon per person, per day, enough for at least 3 days)
- Non-perishable foods (enough to for at least 3 days)
- First aid kit
- Flashlights (extra batteries)
- Manual can opener
- Waterproof container (for important items)
- Cooler and ice packs
- Lighter or matches
- Personal hygiene/sanitation items
- Generators/Gas for generators
- Baby/pet supplies

# **Hurricane Evacuation Routes**

- Hwy 10 East to Hwy 65 North to Montgomery
- Hwy 49 takes you North to Hattiesburg
- Hwy 49 North to Hwy 20 West to Shreveport
- Hwy 10 East to Hwy 85 South to Fort Walton/Destin

# In Case of a Hurricane Evacuation

- RVs will need to be moved and the sites left clean and empty. (If you are not here during the evacuation you will need to find someone to move your RV /stuff)
- If you need somewhere to store the RV, we will have space in our storage lots based upon availability. You must go through the office if you would like to store it. Once the all clear is given you will need to move the RV out of storage within 24 hours.
- You can come back only when the all clear is given.
